In order to graduate, the Class of 2024 & Class of 2025 needs 23 credits and must meet the Ohio Department of Education's permanent graduation requirements (listed on the following page).














Note for Butler Tech Students: Students who attend Butler Tech during 11th and 12th grade are not required to take Applied Communications and College & Career Readiness. Butler Tech's programs build vital communication and college & career readiness skills into their regular two-year lab and academic curriculum. With this, only 4 credits of English are required for students completing a two-year Butler Tech program. Students who attend Butler Tech for 11th grade and then return to Monroe High School for 12th grade will be required to take either Applied Communications or College & Career Readiness during their 12th grade year. This requirement is due to the student not completing the full two-year Butler Tech lab and academic curriculum.
