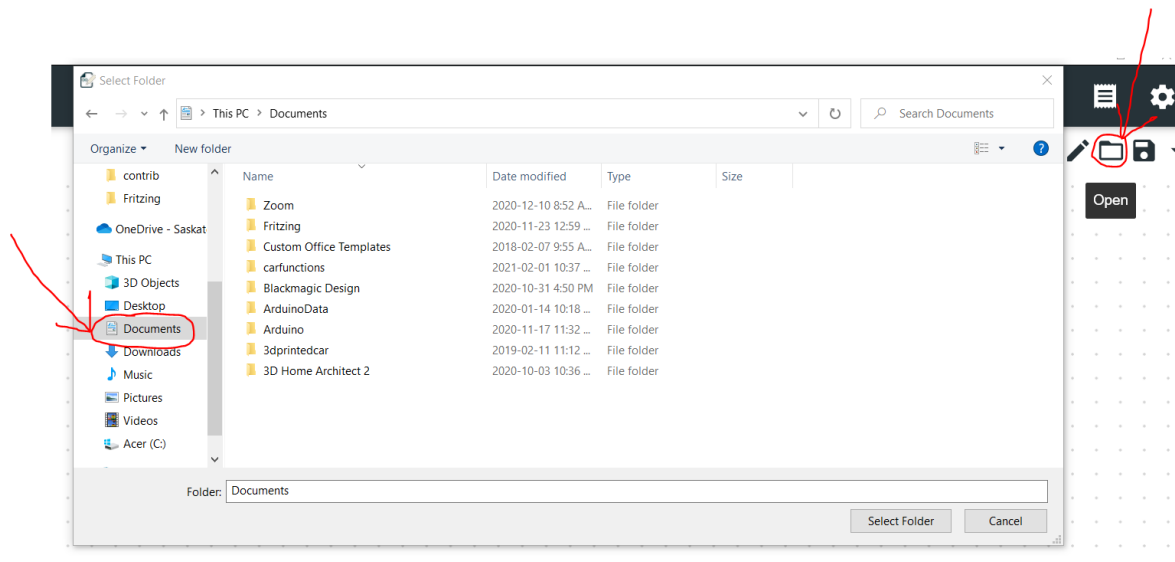
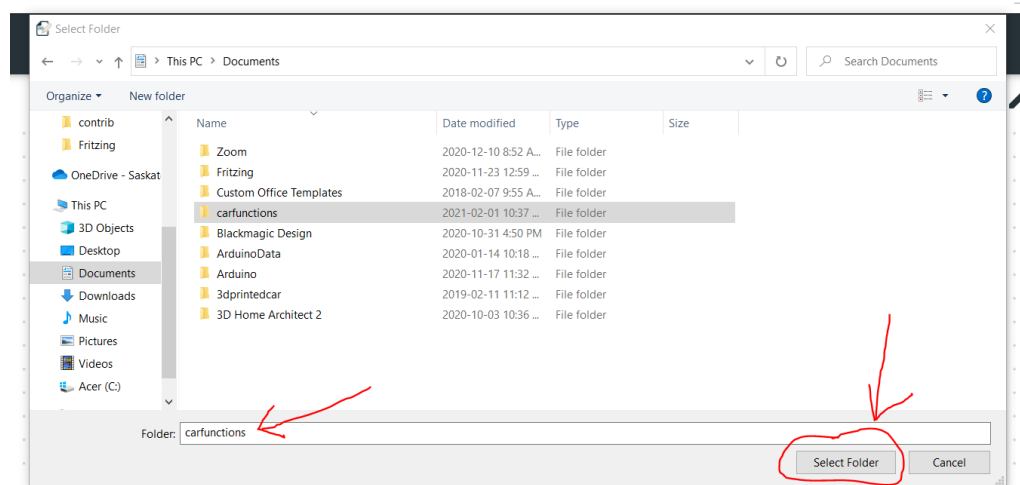


How to Retrieve your BlocklyCode

1. Open up blocklyduino and click on the folder icon. You will need to locate the folder that you saved your code to. I saved my file in documents so I will find my documents folder.



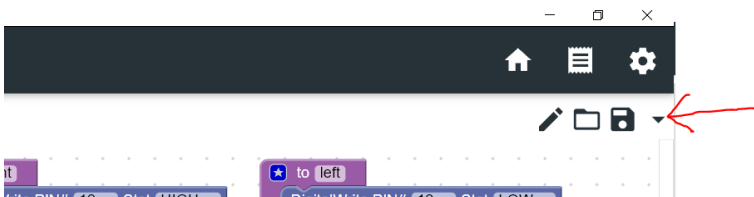
2. Once in your folder, locate your file and click on it. It will appear in the folder bar at the bottom of your screen. You will then click "select folder" and your code will appear in your blockly duino editor.



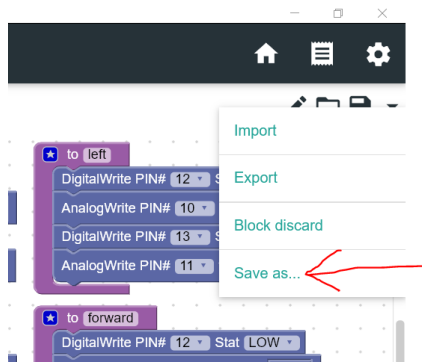
3. Your code should now appear in blocklyduino and you can start to edit.

How to Save Blockly Code

1. To save your code, click on the down arrow



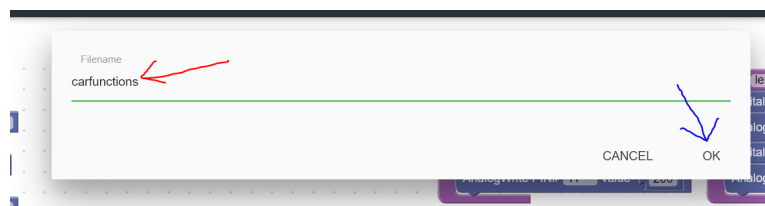
2. Select Save as.



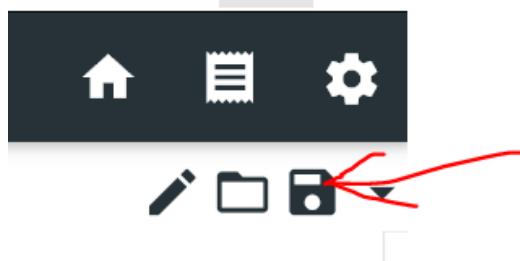
3. Select a folder to save your blocklyduino code to. In this example, I am saving my code to my documents folder. Click "Select Folder."



4. Enter a filename. Ensure that there are no spaces in your filename and call it something that makes sense. I called my file "carfunctions". Click ok. My file is now saved in my documents folder.



5. Now that your file is named, you can click the disk icon to save your file.
