**GM & Ice Report:**

- Ice has been washed and should be in good shape for the State Championship. Will be washed again after the American Legion Bonspiel.
- Dial was replaced on the scraper.

**Financial Report:**

- No new report as accountant has been sick for the last month.
- Last rock payment was made - YAY!
- Expected income still this season:
  - Bonspiels, \$12,000
  - BSU, \$1,500
  - BHS, \$3,000
- With 74 teams signed up for this season it seems we still have a decent amount of unpaid members. We currently have 157 members paid and a few dozen online payments. Eric Fenson will be cross referencing rosters with paid dues to hold members accountable and get dues paid.
- Furnace issues – 2 have been fixed so 4 are now running on the ice. This summer we will need to do some replacements. Eric Fenson will look into using city money for some of these repairs.

- We will be tight at the end of the season and should continue to look for ways to generate more income.

**Bar Report:**

- Jordan prepared a cost comparison sheet of all beverages offered at the bar this season. Also used two weeks of sales provided by Cathy to give a rough estimates of costs and profits for this season. After soda and popcorn expenses we are looking at losing a little under \$700 for the season during league nights at the bar. This sheet will be stored in the Google Drive so it can be updated if new bar offerings are added.
- Cathy will be submitting a Bar Report each meeting and would like to attend in person in the future. Her full report can be found in the Google Drive. In summary:
  - Cathy and Paul are enjoying working the bar this year.
  - They have made a calendar in the Bar Binder with the schedule of events as well as their availability.
  - Cathy is currently using her iPad to play music. The club should look into something that can stay at the bar for all employees to use for music.
  - People are pleased with tap choices, and Cathy thinks people would pay more for the craft LOW. They also noted that our bottles & cans are 12 oz. and our tap pours are 16 oz.
  - Would like a way to accept credit cards.
  - Cathy would like to sell hot dogs at the bar.
- Amanda and Conrad would like to donate their Square Register to the club so we are able to accept cards and make it easier to track sales. Will work on installing on Monday.
