LVDSA's socialist feminist section holds a book club every Tuesday at 8pm. We are currently reading *Abolition. Feminism. Now.*, a remarkable collaborative work by leading scholar-activists Angela Y. Davis, Gina Dent, Erica R. Meiners, and Beth E.
