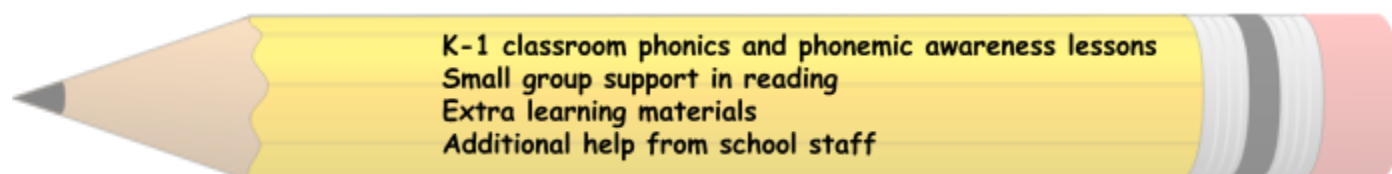
Extra Academic Support for Your Child

- Title I, Part A is a federal program that provides additional academic assistance to students needing academic support in math, reading, and English language arts.
- Learning Assistance Program (LAP) is a state program that offers supplemental services for K-12 students scoring below grade-level standards in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics (only ELA at SES). Services focus on accelerating student growth to make progress toward meeting grade level standards.



Types of Academic Support

Schools provide eligible students additional academic help. Here are 4 examples.



WHAT DOES TITLE/LAP LOOK LIKE AT SES?

Students in K-4th grade
Reading small groups (2-4) or sometimes 1:1
15-30 minute small groups
Push-In Support in Kindergarten
Progress monitoring every two weeks
Focus on: Phonemic and Phonological awareness, decoding, fluency, vocabulary and high frequency words, and comprehension
Programs used: Really Great Reading (Countdown, Blast, and HD), Heggerty, Flyleaf Decodable Books, Primary Phonics, and others.

Each month a newsletter will be sent home with ideas and tips for working on reading and writing with your child.

HOW DID MY CHILD QUALIFY?

After testing students in grades K-5 (benchmark testing) students scoring at the 35th percentile or below are identified. Multiple measures are used and classroom teachers are included in the identification process.
