

The AFGC Memorial Scholarship program was established in 2022 to provide financial support to students majoring in conservation or an environment-related program. It is given to encourage positive contribution to the wildlife management profession. The award will be made in the fall semester. Selection criteria will include academic achievement and written submission.

ELIGIBILITY

Students must:

- be enrolled in a conservation or environment-related certificate/degree program at a recognized college/university
- be registered for classes in the upcoming semester
- be making satisfactory academic progress
- be a New Hampshire resident

Degree programs may include (but are not limited to):

Conservation Law
Environmental Science
Fisheries
Forestry
Marine Biology
Marine Science
Natural Resource Management
Wildlife Biology
Wildlife Conservation

Deadline for applications: Received or post marked by May 1st.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Complete the application form, including the written requirement, submit a copy of transcripts, proof of enrollment, and mail the completed packet to:

SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be evaluated based upon their written submission, academic achievement, educational and professional goals, and their commitment as a future conservation leader.

Each submitted application will be screened by the AFGC Scholarship Committee. Selection of recipient(s) will be made by the end of May.

Scholarships will be awarded directly through the college/university for the fall semester.

SCHOLARSHIP CONDITIONS

The awarded scholarship may be used for tuition, fees, books, room and board, or other related-school expenses. Payments will be made directly to the college/university in the name of student. Thus, the student's identification number will be required only if selected.

Before the check is issued, the committee will confirm with the school that the student is still majoring in a qualifying field of study and registered/enrolled for the upcoming semester.
