**Block #2** = Section 110, Row 13, Seats 107-101, AND Row 14, Seats 107-101 (This equals 14 seats)

The following blocks are groups of 7 seats that are located to the right and left of the center section.

**Block #3** = Section 109, Row 13, Seats 101-107

**Block #4** = Section 109, Row 14, Seats 101-107

**Block #5** = Section 110, Row 13, Seats 1-108

**Block #6** = Section 110, Row 14, Seats 1-108

Available Suites: #101, 108, 110, 117 & 118

\*\*\* Facing the stage, Suite #101 is located on the right where graduates line up before crossing the stage. You would be seeing the back of the graduate as they exit the stage. Two of the suites (108 & 110) face the stage. Facing the stage, two of the suites (117 & 118) are located on the left. The graduates face these two suites as they exit the stage with their diplomas. (See attached floor plan.)

Eleven envelopes total from the three separate raffles will be drawn after school on Wednesday, May 24th-- (5) suites, (2) blocks of 14 seats, (4) blocks of seven seats. Families will be notified by email on the 24<sup>th</sup> if their name was drawn.
