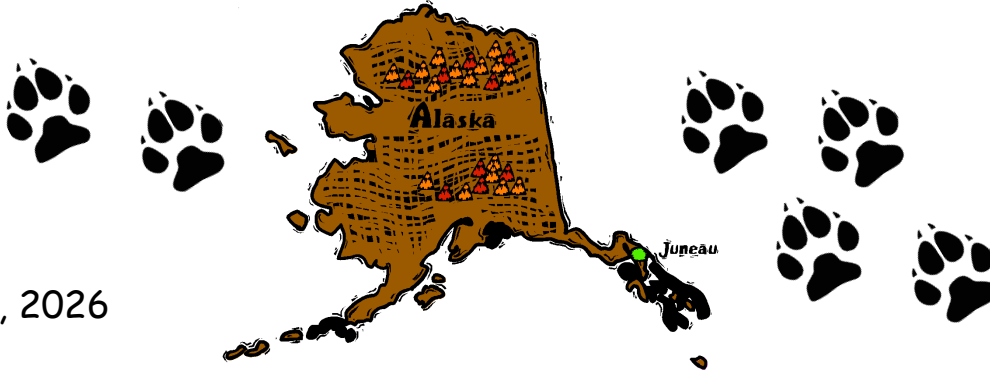


The 2026 JCCS Iditaread Challenge!!

Dear Student,

Congratulations! You are an official participant in the JCCS Iditaread! Your goal is to read one page for every mile of the Iditarod race for a total of 975 pages. This will be hard work, just like it is for the mushers in the Iditarod!

Along the way, you will earn prizes, and those who make it all the way to the finish line will earn a special medal and prize. In order to earn a prize, you will need to read to the various checkpoints listed below:

- Finger Lake: Mile 123 (123 pages) = prize!
- Ophir: Mile 352 (352 pages) = better prize!!
- Nulato: Mile 582 (582 pages) = even better prize!!!
- Koyuk: Mile 804 (804 pages) = really awesome prize!!!!
- Nome: Mile 975 (975 pages) = the coolest prize of all!!!!!!

You will keep track of your reading by recording it on an Iditaread Log and turning in a sheet every week, just like your regular reading logs.

We know that books come in many fonts and sizes, so we ask that you choose books at just the right level for the challenge. Work hard and have fun!! See you at the FINISH LINE! 4/5s - this might help you reach your 19 book challenge!
