International Day of Forests
March 21, 2022

The City Government of Naga in cooperation with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources heads the 1-day celebration of International Day of Forests last March 21, 2022. The event was joined by various partner governmental and non-governmental organizations, academic institutions, volunteer groups and invited guests.

At 6 in the morning, the registration proper was held which roughly accumulated hundreds of participants. The main program proper started at 6:15 in the morning starting with program preliminaries, brief talk from personnel of DENR which included an orientation and introduction about the celebration and awarding of certificate of participation to partner groups. Proceeding, the city mayor addressed the participants through a celebration message. The mayor has also cited the initiative of the city government in the context of environmental concerns. Such as extensive spaces for trees and a greener city.

Afterwards, the invited groups were brought to the FOM site they were assigned to, to plant tree saplings. It is expected that after the ceremonial planting, 2022 trees will be planted. As for the CamHi community, we were assigned at Brgy. San Felipe. Faculty members and students were given tree saplings and were guided to the planting location.

Concluding the event, a photo opportunity with the involved faculty members, organization officers, and the SSG was taken. A separate program by the city government was simultaneously held as it was mentioned to be the launching of the old dumpsite into FOM ecological park.
