God also preserves me by defending me against all danger, guarding and protecting me from all evil. All this God does only because he is my good and merciful Father in heaven, and not because I have earned or deserved it. For all this I ought to thank and praise, to serve and obey him.

We should fear and love God that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and befriend him in every bodily need.

5A David Sins and Repents

Matthew 26:41

Watch and pray, so that you do not enter into temptation.

The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak."

5B Absalom's Rebellion

1 Corinthians 10:24 Let no one seek his own good, but that of others.

1 Peter 5:8

Have sound judgment. Be alert. Your adversary,[a] the Devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour.
