Paul wrote: The "Darkness Fails" scene trimmed-out Tim Curry's final monologue, and with it some of the music cue. The most significant difference however is the synthesizer portamento which is heard over the monologue is moved later — after Darkness is vanquished.

Paul wrote: Lili Awakens (The Ring): My best guess is that Goldsmith decided to alter / adapt the last minute or so of that cue to make for a better listening experience on the album. (The flute / oboe duet is also a different performance on the album than in the film.)

The scene when Lili is revived is much shorter in the EC, and the music when Lili awakens is different from that of the DC. Presumably this trim was made when Goldsmith was still on the picture and able to amend cue. Also, we only hear the first few lines of Lili's song in this scene, though the musical accompaniment remains... (the end of the film is significantly different). Also, get a load of the awful music edit when Jack retrieves the ring! Oy vey!

Paul wrote: The Fairies: The film version of the Fairies *is* indeed longer. It's possible the version on the Silva CD is actually an incomplete take — or perhaps an album version which dispenses with the more “programmatic” conclusion in favor of a more “listener-friendly” conclusion. The brief staccato section before Gimp shouts “Silence!” sounds to me like an excerpt from “Fairy Dance”... I once heard a tape which had some alternate versions. It had a slightly different mix of album version of “Fairy Dance”, which had a solo violin solo added at 1:00-1:08.

Paul wrote: The Freeze: Seems to me that Goldsmith just excised most of the “pulsing synths” passage for the album because it didn't stand alone well.

Paul wrote: Main Title: I suspect Ridley Scott wanted it a little more subdued, so Goldsmith removed the synth chimes (much as he removed the trumpet solo in the "Hypersleep" cue in Alien). Oh, and originally, the Main Title was not written to segue into "The Goblins". "The Goblins" — I am 99% sure — was written for the unused opening sequence of the film (which was later replaced by the simpler montage of woodland images).

Paul wrote: The Unicorns: Paul wrote: There was also an except of "The Unicorns" for which Goldsmith had re-written the synth solo heard at 4:35-4:46. It was a little more complex and busier — but to my mind not as good as the version heard on the album / final film ... I think either Ridley Scott wanted the music "less frenetic" at that moment, and Goldsmith simplified that section of the cue — or maybe that is the way Goldsmith originally composed it, and he decided to alter the cue for the album and re-wrote that passage to be more lyrical. I also once actually heard a *third* version of this section of the cue — in which the synthesizer part accompanying the flute solo was different, and slightly more complex.

Paul wrote: The Riddle: This was truncated on the Silva CD. No idea why. Perhaps that "tapping" noise was a glitch or something and the cue was edited to hide it? Also, I don't know why the original synth intro to "The Riddle" (as heard on the original 1985 album) were cut from the Silva release. Several of the tracks on the Silva CD are comprised of different cues edited together, as in the case of "The Faires / The Riddle".

Paul wrote: "My True Loves Eyes" is mixed differently in the Euro cut. In the Euro Cut we hear Lili singing without the musical accompaniment, whereas in the Directors Cut we initially hear the musical accompaniment without the singing.
