

JUNIOR HIGH / HIGH SCHOOL

Hair

The hair must be neat, clean, and well groomed. Young men's hair may not extend below the eyebrows, or past the ear lobes on the sides at any time. Neither girls nor boys will wear extremely conspicuous hair styles, such as unnatural colors of hair, half-shaved heads or designs with numbers, names, etc. Facial hair must be neat and well groomed. Feathers, tassels, beads, streamers, etc., that are deemed as distracting may not be worn and/or attached to hair. Hair rollers or long-handled combs may not be worn in the hair.

Head coverings

No head coverings of any type are to be worn inside the building by students (male or female) before or during school. This includes but is not limited to hats, caps, wave caps, skull caps, toboggans, do-rags, etc. The only exceptions will be on designated days during spirit week, during athletic practices or competitions, and for safety reasons in the wood or metal shop areas. Students who wear any head coverings in the building will have that article of clothing confiscated and given to the principal. The article of clothing will be returned at the principal's discretion.

Jewelry

Any type of jewelry judged excessive, dangerous, disruptive, or causing disrespect for authority will not be allowed. The District discourages the wearing of expensive jewelry and other expensive apparel and is not responsible for lost or stolen items. No facial/body piercings other than earrings for female students will be tolerated. Earrings are not permitted to be worn by boys and gauges are not to be worn by anyone.

Miscellaneous

Sunglasses should not be worn inside any school buildings unless a student has documentation from a physician stating the need to do so. No bill-fold chains of any type are allowed. Anything that could be considered a weapon is in violation of the dress code. No dog collars or "spike" type collars or bracelets may be worn. Blankets and towels are not proper apparel for wearing on campus. Students may not write on themselves or their clothing. No self-mutilation will be tolerated. No costumes are permitted; the only exception will be on designated days during spirit week. Tattoos must not be vulgar, gang-related, offensive or excessive.

Jurisdiction

Teachers/coaches/sponsors may define appropriate dress for school-sponsored trips and extracurricular activities. The District has jurisdiction over its students during the regular school day and while students travel to and from school on district transportation. The jurisdiction includes any activity and school-related event, regardless of time and location.

Apparel

All shirts, blouses, etc. must cover the entire shoulder. The shoulder must be covered from the neck to the end of the shoulder, and the sleeve must be hemmed. Tank tops, spaghetti straps, muscle shirts, etc., are not allowed. Bare mid-torsos (front and back) are not allowed. Shirts, blouses, etc. must be long enough to cover the mid-torso while the student is sitting, standing, bending over, or raising arms. No bra straps of any kind may be showing. Students must wear appropriate undergarments, and no

undergarments may be visible. Openings in clothing must not inappropriately expose bodies or undergarments. Cleavage must be fully covered. All pants, shorts, and skirts must be worn at the natural waist as intended and must not sag. Excessively long shirts, blouses, etc., must be tucked in. Dresses, skirts, all split garments, and shorts must not be more than 3 inches above the knee while properly worn when standing. Length of the skirt will be measured from the top of the slit, if any is present. Tights/leggings DO NOT change required length of top garments. Clothing with holes (openings in clothing showing skin or undergarments) is not allowed. Excessively frayed clothing is not allowed. See-through, provocative, and excessively tight clothing is not allowed. No pajamas are allowed. Any clothing or decorations on clothing exhibiting implied or suggestive words, phrases, pictures, tobacco or alcohol advertisement, drugs, or any substances under policy FNCF (LOCAL) are not allowed. No clothing may be worn that contains racially offensive symbols, emblems, pictures, or words. Hooded sweatshirts or hoodies may not be worn covering the head inside the building. Yoga pants, tights, leggings, jeggings or any spandex may not be worn as a single bottom garment.

Shoes

Students must wear shoes at all times. House shoes are not allowed.
