This is the Code of Conduct, which appears in junior student handbooks.

Everyone at CES is important. No-one is more or less important than other people. Students, staff, and homestay hosts should all feel comfortable, safe, important and respected. We need your help to make sure this happens. We ask you to agree to these things. All students will:

- accept and respect different beliefs and cultures.
- be honest, polite and respectful to other people (students, staff and hosts).
- never accept abusive or violent behaviour, including sexual, racial, or religious. We will dismiss any student who does not follow this rule.
- look after school property (= our computers, tables, chairs, carpets, DVDs, etc.).
- look after their hosts' property.
- be safe and take care of the safety of other people.
- only use the school computers for their studies.
- not use illegal (bad) websites.
- switch off their mobile phone during lessons
- follow school rules and British laws and customs.
