- District envisioned of different curriculums that all schools are providing in some shape or form vs. the essential skills they want elementary kids to walk away with
- At the end of last year 2 curriculums were provided to every ES : Sources of Strength (3-5) and Second Step Bullying Prevention Awareness (that's what they gave to us)
- Preference to use Zones of Regulation
- Coal Creek SEL YAAG 21-22

- Coal Creeks year at a glance
- Broken down month by month
- ASCA standards
 - Introduced to Zones, Sources of Strength
 - Goal is to build month by month
 - Everything is scaffolded - each year they advance as far as emotional regulation goes. By the time they leave have a great toolbox on how to manage their emotions both in school/out of school
 - Conflict and Bullying came into play Oct/Nov - did use Second Step Bullying Prevention (used across district)
 - Sept - Nov No Place For Hate Curriculum - form coalition (4th graders) get 30 kids excited to do it, got 45 kids. Going to play into some things happening after Thanksgiving break. Includes a pledge. Coalition will go out with tables and paper with pledge on it - different lunch/recesses to pledge to be members of a no place for hate school.
