Dear Teacher Assistant (TA),

Welcome to the teacher assistant program/class. Your decision to participate is appreciated. Assisting a teacher will be a unique, trying, and fun experience designed to give students the opportunity to help students pre-school through 12th grade and/or help teachers with classroom responsibilities. Students in grades 10-12 with an accumulative GPA of 2.00 or higher are eligible to be a TA. Students must have 4 academic classes, excluding tutoring. TA jobs may be available every academic hour. TAs are required to attend the job daily, display appropriate behavior, and maintain passing grades in all subjects. Students may assist teachers each semester. This completed contract must be on file in the high school counseling office prior to the student's placement.

- 1. **ATTENDANCE:** Attendance is taken as in any other class. Plan to spend the entire class period with the supervising teacher every assigned day.
- 2. MODEL BEHAVIOR: Your behavior on the job must be a model for others. Children are looking to you for direction; this includes how you act, talk and what you talk to them about, as well as your attitude. TAs are fair to others and encourage students to do their best. Be aware of and follow classroom rules at all times. Remember, you have a job and you must set a good example.
- 3. **ENCOURAGE** and smile at people you work with. If problems arise, talk with your supervising teacher or see your tutoring advisor. If children misbehave, ask them to please stop. If the problem continues, talk to the teacher.

GRADES

Credit is given at the end of the trimester. The grade is not included in the student's accumulative **GPA.** Ask your supervising teacher how you are doing at mid-term.
