Õppeaine lühikirjeldus	<p>The course deals with both the technical sides of photography (understanding the technical side and handling of cameras, post-processing, publishing), and aesthetic sides of photography. In addition, we will take pictures in many different environments (e.g. nature, portraits, architecture) in which the understanding of the technical side is combined with the aesthetic side. The course will also focus on the organisational side of photography, taking pictures on request, and social media. Students need full access to a camera (DSLR, hybrid/mirrorless, or similar) that allows manual mode, a computer that can run <i>Adobe Lightroom</i> (or work in school to edit their photos).</p> <p>If the weather is good, an evening excursion will take place on 03.06 on Haabneeme beach.</p> <p>NB: the course will take place fully in English</p>
