



RIASEC Hangout: Group Discussion

Directions:

1. Set up 6 stations around the classroom. Each station is labeled with a different letter from RIASEC.
2. Students will label their top three RIASEC letters based on their survey results in the middle of the hexagons. For each letter that was recorded, students will write a sentence on the appropriate hexagon sharing why they think their survey showed that letter of RIASEC.
3. Starting with the first or top code, students will find the correction station that matches their top code. For example, if R (Realistic) was number 1 for the student, they will go to R (Realistic) station. Students will meet up or "hangout" with other students who share the same code. As a group, answer the following questions. Make sure everyone gets to answer.
 - Do you think your personality matches the code? Why or why not?
 - Do you have any interests or activities you enjoy doing that match the code?
 - Did anything surprise you about this code? If so, what?
4. Rotate to the second station. Have students introduce themselves to their new group and answer the same questions with their new group.
5. Rotate to the third station. Have students introduce themselves to their new group and answer the same questions with their new group.
6. Have students return to their seats and be ready to discuss their experiences with the entire class. Have students share their RIASEC results.

People who have artistic, innovating or intuitional abilities and like to work in unstructured situations using their imagination or creativity.

social "Helpers"
People who like to work with people to enlighten, inform, help, train, or cure them, or are skilled with words.

enterprising "Persuaders"
People who like to influence, persuade, perform, lead or manage for organizational goals or economic gain..

conventional "Organizers"
People who like to work with data, have administrative or numerical ability, carry out tasks in detail or follow through on others' instructions.
