STEP 1:	Ask Probing, Critical Questions: <i>Ask as many questions as possible about each of the phrases. Think especially about questions that might uncover global information, perspectives or voices that are missing?</i> <i>(Adapted from the Question Formulation Technique, RightQuestion.org)</i>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ask as many questions as possible, related to the text <i>in each row</i>.<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Note the “Other Questions” at the end.• Do NOT stop to discuss, judge or answer.• Record the questions as asked, except<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Convert statements into questions.• When done, number the questions (from top to bottom)
