Clubs begin on Tuesday, September 5th

This policy is updated on 8.23.2023

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- Only students in grades listed can sign up for clubs
 - Club space is limited and on a first come, first served basis
 - Contact listed club advisor with questions and for necessary application/permission forms.
 - Email club advisors to enroll clubs
 - All students intending to participate must ensure they have a signed consent form, which will be provided by the sponsoring teacher of the club.
 - 3 consecutive unexcused absences will result in dismissal from the clubs. Total absences of 7 days will result in dismissal from the club.

- If a scholar suspends from school, (s)he cannot participate in any extracurricular activity during the suspension period. 1 day of suspension results in 2 days of no participation.
 - A club fee will be applicable, and the proceeds from this fee will be utilized for purchasing materials and providing snacks to club participants.

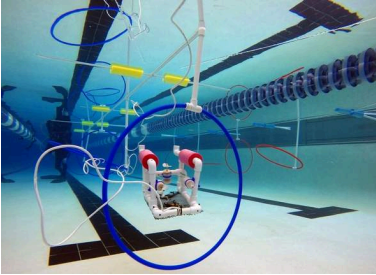

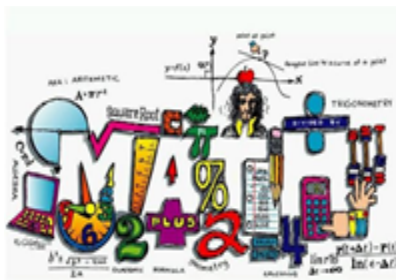

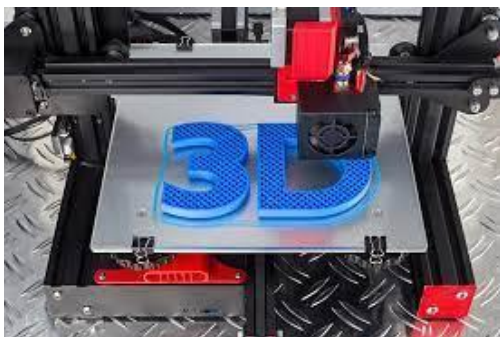
