Level One of the Family Plan Badge

Below are the four challenges required to earn the Lencioni Family Plan Badge.

1. Watch the video embedded in this webpage to introduce you to the idea of Family Plans.

- 2. Read and complete this <u>Family Plan experience</u> from the Acton School of Business which includes <u>reading this note on Family Plans</u>.
- 3. By the first day of school, create a Google document that includes your Family Credo, Mission Statement, and Family Plan and upload it here so we can share it with other families at The Forest School.
- 4. Commit to hold at least four family meetings to check-in on your progress, and put them on your calendar.

Going Deeper

Level Two for the Family Plan Badge

For Level Two of the Family Plan Badge, complete one or more of the following:

- 1. Read the book <u>Three Big Questions for the Frantic Family</u> by Patrick Lencioni.
- 2. Read Steven Covey's book The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Families.
