Course Overview

CP Virtual Roman Civilization is an online course that allows students to investigate the political and social fabric of Roman Civilization and its impact on the historical development of the region. Major trends in religion, social, economic, and political areas will be discussed and assessed. Instruction will be entirely self-driven, emphasizing the inquiry learning model with the teacher serving as a facilitator to assist students in their self-discovery. The teacher will post assignments and activities designed to guide and challenge students during their self-inquiry. Students may occasionally meet with the classroom teacher however, the majority of the study will be self-guided. Students should be self-motivated and are required to have out-of-school access to the Internet.
