2025-2026 Broughton Student Parking Rules and Regulations

- 1. Students with proper registration may park their vehicles in assigned parking spaces. Parking in another lot or space is prohibited. Parking permits must be displayed on the inside rearview mirror post. Any vehicle not displaying its permit can be ticketed, towed or booted.
- 2. A parking tag will <u>not</u> be issued if you have outstanding fees/fines or are not up to date on community service requirements (see this <u>LINK</u>).
- 3. Students may not sell, sub-lease, or give their assigned parking spaces to other students. Students wanting to share a parking space with another student can under certain conditions. If a student wishes to share a space they must inform the administration at the time of purchase.
- 4. No student parking is allowed in the school bus parking lot, faculty lots, visitor spaces, or other undesignated areas.
- 5. There will be no loitering in the parking lots in the morning or afternoon. All students must leave the parking area immediately upon parking their vehicle.
- 6. The safe operation of motor vehicles is required. Vehicles must not travel in excess of 10 miles per hour on campus.
- 7. All traffic laws apply. Seat belts are required for drivers and ALL passengers. No reckless driving is permitted.
- 8. Vehicles should be parked front-end first. Backing into spaces is not permitted.
- 9. Students who operate a motor vehicle on campus should fully understand their duties and responsibilities. Under School Board Policy 7170, students who violate parking regulations are subject to all or any of the following consequences:

Revocation of parking privilege without refund.

Ticketing

Booting, towing and storage of the vehicle, at owners' expense

Disciplinary action

Criminal charges as prescribed by law.

- 10. Students may not switch parking spaces with other students unless authorized by administration.
- 11. Students may only leave school during lunch with an off-campus pass, after school ends, or after being checked out and immediately upon going to the parking lot after school or during lunch.
- 12. A replacement parking tag is \$10.00.

- 13. Handicapped students will be granted first priority for assigned parking.
- 14. Students are expected to comply with all directions of the security officer who will be assigned to the parking area and campus.
- 15. Students may not use their vehicles to illegally take themselves or other students off campus; violations may result in the revocation of parking pass and/or lunch permit.
- 16. Parking a vehicle on campus is a privilege, not a right. Please review all parking regulations with your parents. Email Mr. Bartels, Assistant Principal (mbartels@wcpss.net) for clarification of any matter about which there are questions.
