We define "multicultural" literature as books relating to people of color, countries, cultures, and First/Native Nations individuals, such as: Africans and African Americans, American Indians, Asian/Pacific peoples and Asian Pacific Americans, Latinos and South Americans, Hispanic and Mexican Americans.

Broad search terms in the Turner Library online catalog are: *Multicultural Fiction* and/or *Multiculturalism*.
