

Skit 4: "The Invention of the Telephone"

Characters:

- Alexander Graham Bell - **Ximena**
 - Thomas Watson - **Evan**
 - Scientist - **Yair**
 - Reporter - **Max**
 - Crowd Member - **Aurora**
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Scene 1: Bell's Workshop
