5. Your partner has medical insurance and it covers your children until they are 26. Your 21 year old is traveling overseas. Will insurance cover him in Thailand?
6. Your 4 year old has been creating problems in preschool because he can't stay still or pay attention. You wonder if he has ADHD.
7. Your partner is experiencing extreme headaches that are causing her to miss work. English is not your first language and you don't have insurance.
8. Your 4 month old infant isn't sleeping through the night, meaning you're not sleeping either. You want to help her to sleep on her own. She cries incessantly when you leave her.
9. Your 3 ½ year old was sent home from child care because of head lice. He can't return until it is taken care of.
10. Your 12 year old daughter started menstruating 6 months ago. Recently she's been complaining that her cramps are severe and she's been bleeding more than before.
11. Your 10 year old has been playing soccer for 3 years, and is in good health except for a minor heart murmur that you keep monitored. The school has imposed new rules for student athletics and sends a note home informing you that she can no longer play because of her condition. You want to fight this.
12. Your 2 year old was born prematurely and has a neuromuscular condition. She needs a walker to help assist her and the physician's office doesn't provide it. You need to secure this on your own.
13. Your 60 year old single father has been complaining of a painful rash on his body, mostly on his stomach, chest and upper arms. It's getting worse. He doesn't speak or read English and doesn't have a computer.
14. You and your partner had a baby 2 weeks ago. You notice that your partner (who gave birth) has not been sleeping or eating much, is moody and doesn't seem interested in interacting with the baby.
15. Your 15 year old star cello playing daughter fell on her wrist a couple weeks ago. The pain isn't severe but it still hurts her to play/use the wrist.
16. Your brother-in-law refuses to get the COVID-19 vaccine and your brother (his partner) has asked your help in finding information to convince him.
