Step-by-step Student Instructions for Hypothes.is

Step 1

Create a hypothes.is account at web.hypothes.is
Be sure to remember username and password

Step 2

Add <u>hypothes.is extension</u> using Chrome browser once the extension has been added to Chrome you will find the following symbol to the right of the address window



Step 3

Click on the symbol above and three tabs appear on the right



Step 4

Head to the web page you want to annotate

Open side panel and log in to account

Note: you can now annotate with your peers on a locally stored document. The following link <u>provides YouTube instruction on how to annotate in this manner using Hypothes.is.</u>

Step 5

If your instructor has assigned a closed group for class, please use the link provided to join.

Once you have joined the group be sure to click on Public and choose the correct course group in drop down menu before annotating



Step 6

Start Annotating

Once you are in the correct group, highlight the text you want to comment on and choose:
