1. The Concerto Festival is open to piano students from grades 1 – 12 and consists of **five** divisions: **Elementary, Early Intermediate, Late Intermediate, and Advanced A and B**
2. Please see the OMTA Concerto list to determine the category. Divisions are defined by repertoire, NOT AGE. So, for example, a 9-year-old student performing a Mozart concerto would be in one of the Advanced Divisions. Similarly, a 15-year-old student performing Vandall's Concertino in C Major would be in the Elementary Division. There will be no exceptions. **NO TWOPIANOCONCERTOS!**
3. If you do not see your concerto on the list, please contact the Concerto Committee by October 24th, the application deadline. Friday.
4. Advanced division entries who wish to be considered for a performance with orchestra **MUST** make sure orchestral parts are available for their concerto. Please check Luck's Music or Boosey & Hawkes for availability (See www.syamf.org for instruction on how to do this.)
5. Students may enter only one division.
6. Students are to perform one movement of a concerto by memory.
7. Students are expected to provide an original concerto score for the adjudicators with **numbered measures** on the day of the event.
8. **Awards given will include 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place (with no ties), and Honorable Mention, at the judge's discretion.**
