GRADUATION		
When is graduation day?	June 13th at 6:00 p.m., Friday. Seniors must be at The Greek Theater 2 hours in advance.	
Will I get a cap and gown?	Yes. Please have your Parent/Guardian/Educational rights holder fill out the Cap & Gown Measurement Collection link. The due date to complete the link is March 14th. Check the Schoology resource section for the link also. If you do not submit by the deadline, you are subject to any available remaining size. If you are going to wear heels, make sure to add 2 inches to your height.  In addition to the above form, submit a physical copy of the Cap and Gown Agreement (handed out on 3/4/25) to Mr. Moran at B/G or box in the main office or digitally with the following https://forms.gle/dWPZQCEaUgqQmv4e6	
What if I want to keep my cap and gown?	As of now, you will need to pay \$17.20 to keep your cap and gown at the time you receive your diploma.	
Do I have to pay for a cap and gown?	Caps and gowns will be provided at no cost, but you must return when you come to school to receive your diploma. You must fill out the Measurement Collection form by March 14th.	
When can I pick up my cap and gown	A couple of days before graduation. Exact date: June 9th after Senior Breakfast	
When can I return the cap and gown?	After the graduation ceremony on June 16 - 18 You will return the cap and gown when you come to school to pick up your diploma. If you wish to keep the cap and the gown, it will be \$17.20(subject to change).	
What about graduation speeches?	Graduation instructions and sign-ups can be accessed through this link.	

	Sign-ups will start on March 7th. The Deadline for sign-ups is April 4th, before school ends. Please follow JMHS 2025 Schoology and PA announcements about deadlines
What about graduation music performances?	The music committee will start accepting audition sign-ups. Please see Mr. Ramirez if you want to perform at the graduation ceremony by <b>March 7th</b> .
Will we have graduation clearance?	Yes, you will have clearance, which includes clearance Student Store, Attendance, Senior Contract, Dean, and Library.
When can I return my Chromebooks and textbooks?	Anytime starting June 2.
When can I pick up my diploma?	After graduation, starting June 16. The Counseling Office will be closed wor summer break from June 20 to July 21.
	You need to turn in textbooks, yonder puch, and a chromebook to receive your diploma.  Yes, we will announce in advance. We will have information assemblies (auditorium) the week of May 19

Will we have a rehearsal?	April 19, 20, 21 and 22 during Testing Advisory period (seniors will not take i-Ready)
When are Senior Final Exams?	Final Exams: June 4 - periods 5 and 6 June 5 - periods 1 and 2 June 6 - periods 3 and 4
When are senior grades due?	Grades are due Monday, June 9

How many tickets will I be given for graduation?	5 tickets
Can I get more than 5 tickets?	Yes, you can purchase as many tickets as you wish from the Student Store after school, starting April 28th, price per ticket \$10
Can I still buy Senior items?	Yes. Only individual items will be sold @ student store.  Price list
	PROM
Where is the Prom?	The Prom is on May 24th from 6:30 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. at the Hilton in Universal City.  Parking info:  Self-Parking - \$16 +10% city tax(subject to change)  Valet - \$24+10% City Tax(subject to change)
Can I still purchase a prom ticket?	Yes, there are fewer than 50 tickets available. These limited tickets will be sold until gone, or April 4th. Go to the student to buy at \$225.
Will we have prom attendance clearance?	Seniors must have: - 0 campus <u>CLEAN-UP HOURS</u> owed to be eligible to participate in <u>Prom</u> as of <b>May 9th</b> (Prom is on May 24)
When can I pick up my prom clearance form?	Starting <b>April 23rd</b> , after school, Leadership Bungalow (B/G)
When can I select my prom table?	Priority 1 selection will be on <b>May 14th</b> .  Priority 2 will be on <b>May 15</b> , if necessary May 16th for all. All days will start after school at 4pm.  Priority number order will be posted on Schoology the week of May 12th.

What are the consequences for being absent?	Consequences:  - 1 full day absence of an *unexcused absence = 1 hour campus clean-up - 5 missed periods (unexcused absence) = 1 hour campus clean-up - 7 tardies (unexcused) = 1 hour campus clean-up *within 10 school days of the absence.
How do I clear campus clean-up hours?	Senior campus clean-up is available Monday-Friday between 3:45 and 4:45 p.m.  Short Day Tuesdays and half-days, campus clean-up starts earlier. Report to the skateboard shack. No later than 5 minutes after dismissal.  Questions about absences and/or tardies can be directed to Ms. Martinez, Pupil Services and Attendance Counselor (PSA) email gim5363@lausd.net Questions about Campus Clean-up can be directed to the Dean's Office or on the campus during Nutrition or Lunch.  Campus Clean-up hours assigned by the Dean's Office for behavior issues and ditching must be cleared by the dates identified above for Prom and Graduation.
Is there another way for me to clear my campus clean-up hours?	Yes, you can attend Saturday school. Dates are listed on the flyer (click here for the flyer).  Register here to sign up.
What is an uncleared absence?	Absence not verified with proper documentation and parent/guardian signature within 10 school days.
Will we have prom clearance?	Yes, you will have clearance, which includes clearance Student Store, Attendance, Senior Contract, Dean, and Library.
When can I pick up my prom clearance sheet?	April 28th, after school at 4 pm. Bungalow G window.

Can I take a guest to prom?	Yes, if you would like to take a single guest, a guest form must be filled out and submitted before purchase. One guest per senior.
Where do I get a guest form, and how does it work?	Guest forms are available in Ms. Danielyan's office, in B/G, or in the Schoology Resources folder. The form must be filled out and signed by Mr. Colato and Ms. Danielyan. Two pages must be stapled: a valid ID(school or California) of the guest and the completed form. The form must be physically handed to Ms. Danielyan. Show the copy/picture of the form to the student store to purchase the ticket.
What if I want to sign up for Prom Court?	Prom Court sign-ups will start May 5th and end May 9th. The sign-up link will be posted on Schoology.
Can I buy a yearbook?	Yes, through Jostens @ Jostens.com. The last for online orders is TBD, but will still be sold at the Student Store.
Can I buy a page in the yearbook?	Yes, you can buy ads through Jostens @ www.theyearbookcompany.com \$195 Full page \$125 Half page \$95 Quarter page (not including processing fees) contact a yearbook representative for assistance. Wednesday, February 4th, is the last day.

When do I need to submit my media release form and senior contract? Why?	Submit the media release form to this site  Media/Senior contract submission  This is important because we want to make sure everyone is featured in a graduation video.

Application/Contract/Info and Instructions are in the Grad Nite Contract  Grad Nite ticket sales: February 27 at 4:00 p.m. and March 26 at 4:00 p.m., Bungalow G \$190.00 per person. Includes bus transportation and grad night party at California Adventure
How much does the Grad Night ticket cost?	The cost of the ticket will be <b>\$190 per person</b> . This includes transportation and the cost of admission to the Grad Night party at California Adventure.
Is there an application/contract for the Grad Night?	Applications will be available via the <b>Grad Nite Contract</b> Please check JMHS 2025 Schoology and the senior class's Instagram for the announcements. The Grad Night contract must be completed before purchasing (link above).
How do we purchase Grad Night tickets?	The ticket sales (one day only) will be held on <b>February 27, at 4:00 p.m. at Bungalow G. However,</b> a second day has been open. Wednesday, March 26, at 400 p.m. at Bungalow G.
Is there Grad Night clearance?	"Yes, you have to be cleared by the Dean's Office and by the Attendance Office (0 campus clean-up hours) and have graduation status.  If you have campus cleanup hours pending, you CAN purchase a grad night ticket. You will need to have 0 hours by June 10th. Are there still Grad Nite tickets available?	As of now, there are fewer than 100 tickets left.  Alumni will have a final sale on Wednesday, March 26, at 4:00 p.m. at Bungalow G.  Application/Contract/Info and Instructions are in the link below  Grad Nite Contract
When is Powder Puff, and how do I sign up?	Powder Puff will be on the football field on Friday, March 21st. Time: 4:00 p.m. Sign-up will be February 3 - February 7 at the table next to the student store.
What do I need to participate in Powder Puff?	You need to have a completed L.A.C.E.R. application turned in to the students at the sign-up table no later than February 10.  In addition, you need to attend all practices(details on that to come) and You must also have academic clearance (Athletic GPA is no less than 2.0) and dean clearance (no MISI discipline referrals and zero campus clean-up hours).
Are there announcements from the Library?	If they have received an overdue notice from Ms. Lemus (sent every M/W/Friday), you need to contact Ms. Lemus and inquire - don't wait until the last minute.
