Simple Family History Goals in Minutes

These monthly goals are for individuals and families and would make great Family Home Evenings or Sunday activities. This goal is designed to learn how to add an individual to FamilySearch. You can practice in the "Living Space" where it is unique to your account and no one else will see it.

GOAL 2

Add a Missing Family Member

Missing deceased and living family members may be added to the FamilySearch tree. Living people will only be seen by you. It is not necessary to add living people to your account, but you may wish to add siblings, children, grandchildren, etc.

PC HOW TO

In FamilySearch select the "Family Tree" Tab and then "Tree" in the dropdown menu. Select "Landscape" view in the upper left corner.

Add CHILDREN, SIBLINGS, Etc:

Step 1:

- In the pedigree, find the parents of the individual you would like to add (or go to a parent's person page by clicking on their name and click "Add Child")
- In the pedigree, under the parents' names, **click** on the down arrow that is next to "Children"
- **Click** on "Add Child"
- See **Step 2**

Add GRANDCHILDREN:

Step 1:

- Find the parents of the individual you would like to add and click on one of their names
- At the bottom of the summary box **click** on "Tree"
- Under their names, **Click** on "Children" and then "Add Child"
- See **Step 2**

Add PARENTS, SPOUSE, or GRANDPARENTS:

Step 1:

- Find the person who needs parents or a spouse and **click** on "Add Father", "Add Mother", or "Add Spouse"
- See **Step 2**

Step 2:

- Under “Status” **click** “Deceased” or “Living” and “Male” or “Female”
- **Add** as much other information as you know or desire (if living, only you will see it)
- **Click** on “Next”
- If you are adding a LIVING individual, **click** “Create Person.” If adding a DECEASED person, FamilySearch will search its database for a similar deceased person. If it finds the deceased person you are missing, **click** “Add Match”. If it doesn’t find the deceased person click “Create Person.”
- A LIVING individual will be added to your private account (only you will see it). A DECEASED individual will be added to the public tree where all can see it.

FAMILY TREE APP HOW TO

Add CHILDREN, SIBLINGS, and GRANDCHILDREN:

Step 1:

- From the pedigree **tap** on the parent of the missing individual
- Beneath the name box **tap** the “Spouses” tab
- **Tap** “Add Child”
- See **Step 2**

Add PARENTS, SPOUSE, or GRANDPARENTS:

Step 1:

- From the pedigree **tap** on “Add Father”, “Add Mother”, or “Add Spouse”
- See **Step 2**

Step 2:

- **Tap** the gender and add the name
- **Tap** “Continue”
- **Tap** “Deceased” or “Living” and **add** as much information as you know or desire (if living, only you will see it)
- If you are adding a DECEASED individual **tap** “Continue”
- If you are adding a LIVING individual, **tap** “Add This Person.” If you are adding a DECEASED person FamilySearch will search its database for a similar deceased person. If it finds the deceased person you are missing, **tap** “Add Match”. If there is no matching person found, then select “Add This Person”
- A LIVING individual will be added to your private account (only you will see it). A DECEASED individual will be added to the public tree where all can see it.
