

LOPWGC GENERAL MEETING MINUTES
JULY 6, 2022

The meeting was called to order by Captain, Terry Karnezis. There were 19 members in attendance.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. Kris reported we have a balance of \$17,180.75, remaining budgeted items of \$7,404.31, leaving a working balance of \$9,776.44. We made \$40 on the Past Captain's tournament.

Captain's Report – Terry asked members to send photos of golfing to her for inclusion on the LOP.org website. She also thanked Barbara K. for her great job running the Past Captain's tournament.

Terry also presented Peggy Brewer with her hole-in-one plaque. (It's Peggy's 5th hole-in-one!)

Co-Captain – Linda reminded us that players may participate in the red eclectic only once a week and must declare participation at the beginning of a round. Each week lasts from Sunday through Saturday.

Golf Committee – Terry reported that holes #3 and #17 will be worked on next year. The women Niners presented a list of concerns to the committee based on their member survey. Results indicated green tees on #4 and #6 need attention. The men are working on blue/white tee combinations in preparation for course rating coming up in August. Our Board did not feel red/green combo or green/gold combo data needs to be added to the scorecard. A suggestion was made that various holes be temporarily closed to give tees and greens time to heal. Ilene needs to know when holes are closed. Finally, we do not have green "official measuring discs" at this time.

Tournament Chair – Ilene congratulated Paula Glass as the low net winner for June with a score of 63!!! Way to go, Paula!

Open Days – Jo reminds us that July 15 at 8:00 a.m. enrollment begins for Open Days for the rest of the year.

Match Play – Allison stated July 16 we will play Del Paso. We did well against Winchester and the team in general is doing well.

Red Eclectic - Val has placed the scorecards in a box in the pro shop. The red eclectic will end October 31st. Please be sure you play with a woman 18er who will validate your scores.

Four Man Best Ball – Pat announced that the July 20th tournament will cost \$10 payable to the envelope in the pro shop. Lunch will be purchased by players individually. Players may play from red or green tees.

President's Cup/Club Championship – Sandy thinks we will probably have a modified shotgun on August 24 and 31. More information will be coming including a sign-up sheet.

Couples' Tournament - The Sept. 10th tournament theme will be "Bummer – End of Summer!" The cost remains to be determined – probably around \$40-\$50 per person. More information will be coming.

Invitational – Diana and her committee are planning the October 11 and 12 invitational with a "Mad Hatter" theme. They are considering one practice/fun day and one serious play day. The first fun day may end with appetizers at Diana's home. It was suggested that day could be a sweeps day. Patti A. volunteered to head organizing the sponsors' letter and signs for the course. Patti will contact those who found sponsors last year.

Guest Day – Donna C. reminded us of the August 17th tournament. Information will come out next week including a sign up sheet. It will be casual with individual ordering of lunch. Cost is \$15 for guests; women Niners may be invited. (Remember it is 18 holes.) Allison has the names of several people who would like to play here and be invited if players don't know others to invite.

Team Play – Sandy M. said Debbie B. reports that we are now 9 points out in front. Several teams scored more than 40 points at Nevada County. Debbie needs players for Alta Sierra and LOP. Sign up sheet is in the library.

Saturday, August 27th - The women have this Saturday for play and a "Fun Day" is being planned. We can invite Niners who like to play 18 holes or guests from outside LOP. It will be casual with players ordering their own lunches.

Rules – Peggy led a discussion related to the videos sent to members related to hitting provisional balls. In general, an original ball hit into a penalty area cannot be followed by a provisional ball. Please look at the rules information sent each month. The discussions are complicated and rules cannot be explained in the minutes.
