Four Day a Week Schedule	 All students, except full remote, attend school on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. All students work remotely on Wednesdays.
Full Remote Students	 All Junior High and High School students attend live lessons virtually Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday for all of their classes following the master schedule's class times (listed below). To attend live lessons virtually, elementary students will follow the schedule given to them by their teachers as noted in google classroom and on the weekly overview. High School Testing on Wednesday, October 14, 2020	 PSAT/SAT testing for all high school students PSAT is for students in 9th - 11th grade. This is a practice SAT test and takes about 3 ½ hours. The SAT test is for 12th grade students. This is their college reportable test and takes about 4 ½ hours. These tests are make-up from the testing missed in the spring. Students needing transportation should contact Mrs. Wagner. Students should plan on arriving to school by 7:45 Testing begins at 8:00 on Wednesday, October 14, 2020. All students should attend testing.

Breakfast	 The state has extended the free meal program for all students Elementary students may go to the cafeteria for breakfast after they arrive in the classrooms. Students in jh/hs will have a grab 'n go option found in the lobby for breakfast.
Lunch	The state has extended the free meal program for all students, at least until the end of December. So all students will eat for free. Remote Meal Pick Up	 If you would like your Remote student(s) to have breakfast and lunch provided for them, please note these distribution times: Full Remote Students: they may pick up all of their meals for the week on Monday mornings from 8-10:30am at the back (north) side of the school building Four (4) Face-to-Face Students: they may pick up meals on Tuesdays at 2:45pm in the cafeteria for their meals on Wednesdays and then they may pick up meals on Fridays at 2:45pm for Saturday and Sunday If your student will have a difficult time carrying several days worth of meals on their own, regardless of their learning format, you may also pick up meals on Wednesdays from 8:00 a.m 10:30 p.m. in the back (north) side of the building.
Bus	 Families must sign up to have their student(s) ride the bus Students must sit in assigned seats. Siblings will be placed together. Masks must be worn at all times. Passes and intermittent riding will not be granted permission.
Departure	 Elementary students walking or being picked up will depart through their classroom doors. Students are expected to go directly to their vehicles or designated after school location. Students should not congregate or socialize upon dismissal. Parents are expected to wait in their vehicles or outside with six feet distance for one another when picking up their children. Bus riders will board the bus in the back of the building. Siblings should meet in front of the building at the end of the day or on the bus. K-2 parents, please pick up your littles on the Morris Street side of the building and we will have someone guiding them safely to you.
