

Minimizing Harm in the Digital Age (Humane Tech)

Let's discuss privacy issues and minimization of harm in the digital age – to protect us as citizens and digital users. First, **choose between either of these nonprofit organizations' sites, spending half an hour checking out their issues, blogs/podcasts, action items, and proposed solutions/toolkits:**

1. [Electronic Frontier Foundation](#) (a focus on digital privacy rights, and avoiding surveillance by government and marketers, and protecting our free speech). OR
2. [Center for Humane Technology](#) (the organization that brought you the documentary *The Social Dilemma*, challenging the ethics/policies of manipulative tech design that can hijack our attention, spread disinformation, and harm our wellbeing).
