- Soothing Suds: Bring the calm to cold process and melt-and-pour soaps with the signature blue hue and soft, sweet scent of Tansy Blue Essential Oil. Use at 0.25–1%. Start with a trial batch to find your ideal color and fragrance strength.
- Blue Flame Beauty: Add a touch of luxury to candles with this mellow, fruity-floral middle note. Perfect for spa-inspired blends and relaxation-focused collections. Use Tansy Blue Essential Oil at 1–5% of the fragrance load, depending on wax type and scent strength desired.
- Scent with Intention: From pulse-point rollers to high-end perfumes, Tansy Blue brings an unexpected twist with its earthy, slightly fruity aroma. Use 0.1–2% of Tansy Blue Essential Oil depending on the intensity you're after. Test in small batches before scaling.
- Complexion Companion: A go-to for serums, creams, balms, and facial oils, Tansy Blue is loved for its skin-soothing properties and gentle aroma. Use 0.1–0.5% of Tansy Blue Essential Oil in leave-on products. As with any new skin care ingredient, patch testing is recommended before full use.
- Blue-Ribbon Hair Care: Soothing for the scalp and aromatic for the senses, add Tansy Blue to conditioners, masks, and scalp treatments. Use at 0.1–0.5% and blend with nourishing carriers

like argan or jojoba for best results.

- Blissful Baths: Infuse bath oils, body butters, and scrubs with the calming scent and rich blue tone of this Moroccan gem. Use 0.1–1% of Tansy Blue Essential Oil, blend well, and test in a small batch if your formula contains white bases.
- A Breath of Blue: Add a few drops to your diffuser or an aromatherapy blend to create a mellow, comforting atmosphere. Start with 1–3 drops of Tansy Blue Essential Oil per 100mL of water or adjust to preference.
