

Found Object Color Wheel (3-5)

Purpose:

Colors are everywhere, both outside and inside our home. Ever wonder why some colors work so well together? Artists use the color wheel to better understand relationships between colors. With that knowledge you will be able to make more choices when creating art. Today you will create a one-of-a-kind color wheel by looking around and gathering objects in your own house. Look in your bookshelf, toys, kitchen, fridge, desk, bathroom, closet...and more!



Materials:

- Floor, table, couch, or any surfaces to arrange your found objects.
- Objects found inside your home: books, toys, kitchen tools, plants, food, stationary, art supplies...

Directions:

1. Walk around your house and choose objects that match with the colors.
2. Repeat step 1 until you find Primary, Secondary and all other colors to complete the color wheel.
3. Reflection: Which colors are warm? Which ones are cool? Why do you think Analogous colors (ex: yellow, yellow-green, green) work so well together?
4. Take a picture of your color wheel and share with your Mrs.Black.
5. Put objects back to where you found them.
