Summer Band Expectations

REQUIRED MATERIALS - All students will be required to have the following items for summer band:

- Athletic shoes (running, cross-training, etc); students will not be able to participate without the correct shoes
- Hat

- LIGHT COLORED comfortably fitting t-shirts
- Water Jug
 - Students will not be allowed to participate without a FILLED water jug

The 2024-2025 Physical Form is now available on the VHS Band website. [Physical Form](#). You will turn this in on Registration Day on July 27th. Your student will not be able to attend summer band without a physical form on file.

- If your student has had a physical since Dec 1, 2023, you can drop it to your doctor to complete as their past physical will cover all of band season.
- If your student has not had a physical since Dec 1, 2023, schedule a physical before July 27th and bring the physical to be completed by the doctor so you can turn it in on July 27th Band Registration day.
