Important Items and Documents

- ☐ Passport(s) with visas (as needed)
- ☐ Health and immunization records
- ☐ Personal Computer
- ☐ Bible

Items for the Room

- ☐ Toiletries (& something to carry them in)
- ☐ Clothes Hangers
- ☐ Pillow with two pillow cases
- ☐ Two sets of sheets for single bed
- ☐ Blankets, quilt or duvet
- ☐ Twin bed mattress cover
- ☐ Two towel sets (bath, hand and washcloth)
- ☐ Alarm clock (recommended for grades 9 & 10)

Miscellaneous

- ☐ 50-100 Euros for student dorm account (for emergencies- optional)
- ☐ 30-50 Euros per month for student dorm account or on a bank card (snacks, toiletries, Doner, etc)
- ☐ Sleeping bag
- ☐ Medication: Prescription, pain reliever, cold, allergy, or other specific medications your child may need (will be kept secure for your child by the residence staff)

Optional

- ☐ Phone (most students use their phones w/o a SIM card on school, dorm & local wifi)
- ☐ Water Bottle
- ☐ Study Lamp
- ☐ Pictures for wall - ask dorm staff how to hang items
- ☐ Musical instrument
- ☐ Bicycle (dorms will also have some to use)
- ☐ Sports Equipment
- ☐ Throw rugs
- ☐ Hobby materials
- ☐ Beach towel
- ☐ Watch
- ☐ Portable Fan

Clothing (see HS Handbook for dress code)

- ☐ School clothes - jeans (at least 4 pairs), pants, 10 shirts including dress shirts, t-shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters, etc. (sweatpants or Athletic pants cannot be worn to school)
- ☐ Dress clothes (Boys) - dress shirt, slacks, jacket or suit (optional) or nice sweater, ties for Christmas Banquet, Junior/Senior Banquet)
- ☐ Dress clothes (Girls) - casual dresses, skirts, formal dresses (Christmas Banquet, Junior/Senior Banquet)
- ☐ Clothing for cold weather/snow activities - hats, boots, gloves
- ☐ Sports clothes - shorts, t-shirts, athletic / sweatpants
- ☐ Jackets - one lightweight, one rain jacket, one winter jacket
- ☐ Undergarments - enough for at least 7 days
- ☐ Socks - 10-12 pairs
- ☐ Nightwear - bathrobe (optional), slippers, pajamas
- ☐ Footwear - sneakers (at least one pair with non-marking soles), casual shoes, dress shoes, house slippers / slides (German law requires hard-soled shoes in the kitchen)
- ☐ Swimsuit - modest tankini or one piece for girls, swim shorts for boys

School Supplies

When classes start, teachers will tell students what is needed. Students will be able to purchase school supplies on a shopping trip with their dorm.
