Presented by: Kate Williams, RTD District A Board Member,
Doug Monroe-RTD manager of corridor planning,
Bill Sirois-RTD community manager

- Kate shared:
 - o Her journey as a board member, unpaid position
 - District A is smallest district but includes downtown
 - Advocate for disabled and transit nerds
 - Ride patterns have adjusted to more middle of the day
 - Adopt a stop program to help improve the bus stops;

- The bench, structures, trash cans, advertising are owned by City and not RTD (Rail stops are RTD responsibilities)
- Ecopass system still available
- There is also an Neighborhood Eco Pass program available for neighborhoods

• Doug shared:

- His position and responsibilities
- Dedicated lane on Lincoln has improved the bus on time performance
- Reimagine RTD less impact to core areas nearer the city (like us)
 - Focus on core for 15 min service
 - No service cuts planned in our area (route 0, route 0 limited during peak), Lincoln/Broadway, Logan, Alameda

• Bill shared:

- His position and responsibilities
- RTD is also doing a redistricting in time with the overall council redistricting; will be reviewed at board meeting next week
- West metro growing more than east and are therefore shifting: https://www.rtd-denver.com/board-district-map
- Reimagine RTD system optimization plan is out for review which addresses changes in next 5 year
 - Workforce and support staff challenges, operating at 70% of pre-pandemic levels
 - Also challenges on funding side
 - Focus on equity of needs
