The young goat meat is extremely priced because its soft whilst older goat meat is processed into foodstuffs like salted, smoked and cured meat.

Brush, Kiko, Myotonic, Spanisha plus West African Dwarf goats are other breed of goats you can raise to produce goat meat.

3. Milk Goats:

Since goat dairy has fewer levels of lactose, a lot of folks prefer this milk rather than cow milk. Goat milk can even be used in the production of buttermilk, cheese, yogurt, clarified butterfat, candy and a lot of beauty products.

If you are considering raising goats for milk then the Anglo-Nubian breed produces the best quality goat milk. Some other breeds that produce good milk are Alpine, Oberhasli, Saanen and La Mancha breeds.
