- Aegon Stormbreaker (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 4: Turingtown, Part 4]
 - The leader of the heroes of Navarene. Sacrificed himself to stop the Apocrita, but eventually became its willing host. See also: Loell.
- The Apocrita [First Appearance Ep. 4: Turingtown, Part 4]
 - A cloud of spiders that consumes its victims and uses their memories to create obsidian replicas. It's victims are stuck reliving their most important memory indefinitely.
- Argent [First Appearance Ep. 26: Questionable Measures, Part 8]
 - A device that can pull any item from the past or future within a set distance from its radius. Was designed after an item Hop destroyed called the Dotwave. Hop destroyed Argent, as well.
- Bee (they/them) [First Appearance Ep. 64: One Neon Night, Part 6]
 - A glowing sphere of green light that can power up pryliman machines, but primarily lives inside of a vine. Seems to have been born in the ruins of Prylima.
- Coltrane Bar [First Appearance Ep. 2: Turingtown, Part 2]
 - Obsidian Bay's bar, and also the location of our heroes' first fight.
- Commander TJ (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 72: Xoc's Memory, Part 1]
 - The (former) leader within the Angulan Knights who trained Aegon's unit. Once remarked that "you've gotta put your biceps into a proper door knock."
- craves [First Appearance Ep. 72: Xoc's Memory, Part 1]
 - o Ant-like crustaceans that move in clumps and can light up.
- The Datasphere [First Appearance Ep. 1: Turingtown, Part 1]
 - A version of the atmosphere that certain individuals can access for information and spells.
- Datasphere Patron [First Appearance Ep. 42: Crime and Courtship, Part 7]
 - A creature from the Datasphere that grants magical abilities to its target. For example, Sunny is Mayra's patron, and Misha is Xoc's Patron.
- Defibrilimb [First Appearance Ep. 55: Crime and Courtship, Part 19]
 - A mechanical arm designed by Mako to safely extract Apocrita spiders from potential victims, aided by an AI that exists within the arm. It also shoots lasers.
- disassembler [First Appearance Ep. 4: Turingtown, Part 4]
 - A robot with multiple appendages designed to tear down machines. MARSHAL modified it to work on humans, as well.
- Don (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 5: The Clockwork City, Part 1]
 - A disgruntled moustached man who used to work for the Charmonde police force. Quit the force with help from the party, and gave them a bottle filled with nearly infinite energy.
- The Heart of Charmonde [First Appearance Ep. 12: The Clockwork City Part 8]
 - A series of gears underneath Charmonde that powered the city via a blue light that contained nearly infinite energy. Was destroyed by Mako when the party helped him escape the city.
- Inuki (she/her) [First Appearance Ep. 5: The Clockwork City, Part 1]

- A young Xi-Drake who formed an inseparable bond with Loell and was consumed by the Apocrita. Her obsidian form prefers the taste of flying cars to flowers.
- The Ladybug [First Appearance Ep. 37: Crime and Courtship, Part 2]
 - The vehicle of choice for the Quest Friends, created by Jesse. The Ladybug is a spotted vehicle with multiple compartments, insect-like legs instead of wheels, a giant beanie that lets it fly, and many, many tarps where its trunk should be.
- Loell (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 12: The Clockwork City, Part 8]
 - A "brain bud" that only Xoc can see and interact with. Wants to use the Apocrita to consume the Heroes of Navarene and keep them "alive" forever. See also: Aegon Stormbreaker.
- The Kool-Aid Man (he/him)
 - The Kool-Aid Man, but with sunglasses. Sometimes bursts through walls, but oftentimes has just been there the entire time.
- Mako (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 5: The Clockwork City, Part 1]
 - A medic, inventor, and member of the Heroes of Navarene. Uploaded an AI into the defibrilimb called the Mako OS. Consumed by the Apocrita.
- MARSHAL JARVIS (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 4: Turingtown, Part 4]
 - Obsidian Bay's research robot, who was corrupted by the Apocrita into replacing the town's citizens with duplicates that could be uploaded into a hivemind.
- Marv Strongarm (he/him) [First Appearance Ep. 5: The Clockwork City, Part 1]
 - The eternally calm mechanic of the Heroes of Navarene. Aegon's mentor, Sue's husband, and creator of the "club sandwich that looks like an actual club."
 Consumed by the Apocrita.
- Obsidian Bay [First Appearance Ep. 1: Turingtown, Part 1]
 - A mining town built on Pryliman ruins that accidentally unearthed Aegon
 Stormbreaker. Now serves as the floating city in the center of the obsidian cloud.
- Prylima [First Appearance Ep. 7: The Clockwork City, Part 3]
 - A floating kingdom of rotund stone automatons that designed Redd's Blessing to fight the Apocrita, but was taken over nonetheless. Obsidian replicas of Prylima's citizens serve as the Apocrita's main attack force.
- Redd's Blessing [First Appearance Ep. 55: Crime and Courtship, Part 19]
 - A spear with ropes and a prismatic tip. When stabbed into the Apocrita, it forces the Apocrita and its wielder(s) onto a "battlefield of memories." If the wielder loses, they become the Apocrita's new host.
- Salad Raptor (he/him) [First Appearance The Cookie Three, Part 1]
 - A Chuck E. Cheese-style animatronic singing raptor with a salad bowl on his head.
- String of Binding [First Appearance Ep. 10: The Clockwork City, Part 6]
 - A string that indefinitely extends, allowing it to bind multiple appendages in a single knot.
- <u>Totalus Rankiu</u>m
 - A pair of light-hearted history podcasts ranking all of the Roman Emperors and US Presidents. The guest stars of <u>The Cookie Candidate</u>.

- The Weal of Baz [First Appearance Ep. 36: Crime and Courtship, Part 1]
 - A secluded haven for machines that has grown even more distant from the rest of the world over the centuries. Basically a sci-fi old folks' home.
