some of them are incredibly keen for
that kind of thing and so it was just
another way to try and engage them
uh and you mentioned that you're
developing it so you're developing some
resources for easter is that in the
seminars yeah done it say exactly the
same thing

so we took a series of 360 images across
the college

and then um unlike hiding christmas
presents i've then photoshopped
easter eggs on yellow eggs take you
forwards and backwards blue eggs are
tasks the tasks linked to classroom or
century tech or it's a youtube video
with a question

even study stack which you directed us
to and the lovely american guy who set
it up in 2001 has very sweetly
amended the snowman hangman to mean that
the caveman one can be an optional extra

in the embed link
which suited us because we've done
jurassic park this term so they got a
they got a hangman that came up with a
dinosaur that eats you if you don't get
the word right
that's brilliant so you contacted it you
contacted the owner
well i contacted tech support thinking
nothing had ever happened and the
the founder replied and went yeah i
think i can do that for you what's up
okay wow is that okay yeah that's
amazing cheers
that's really good um and so were you
using the ricoh cameras
to do that uh no oh hang on the
what the 360 happens yes so
um at first this is a really lovely
learning curve i suppose at first when
you gave them to us
when we borrowed yours um i couldn't
really make
the colleges work they were brand new
now it was lovely it was all very
autonomous
uh hired the cameras and had a very
jolly time
stomping around the back of bca's
enormous campus choosing where to put
the camera
and i even had great fun downloading the
images and then
finding a piece of software that i could
edit out the tripod and hide me
where i was lurking behind a bush and so
yes i've completely vanished from all of
them but the cameras were
invaluable and then because we've used
all of our free views

we'd had two thousand and it was telling
