

Homemade Laundry Soap

(Low Suds works well in “*he* washers”)

Ingredients:

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup Arm and Hammer Super Washing Soda

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup 20 Mule Team BORAX

1 bar Unscented Ivory Soap or Fels Naptha Bar

Water

Supplies Needed:

Grater

Wooden Spoon

Pot

Measuring cup (1 cup and $\frac{3}{4}$ cup)

2-3 gallon container with lid



Directions:

Grate or chop bar of soap into small pieces and put in pot.

Add 6 cups of water.

Melt at medium low heat for 30-40 minutes.

Add powders to pot with melted soap.

Dissolve powders in a couple of minutes.

Put 4 cups hot water in bottom of bucket.

Pour melted mixture into bucket.

Add 1 and a half gallons of tap water to bucket.

Optional: add fragrance such as lavender, lemon, orange or tea tree essential oils.

Use about 1/2 to 3/4 cup per load of laundry wash.
