Section 1. General

- a. The Area 5 2026 Basic Watch Schedule (BWS) will be split into 3 separate seasons as follows:
 - i. **Spring** -1/11/2026 5/30/2026
 - ii. Summer -5/31/2026 9/5/2026
 - iii. Fall 9/6/2026 1/9/2027
- b. Unless otherwise stated below, BUEs will select one schedule line from each of the seasons during the first round of bidding.
- c. Due to assignment to various details Jason Phelps (EL) and Susanne McLean (MS) will select "ghost" schedules and annual leave slots from available schedules and leave. Due to an unknown Return to Duty date Sam Thomas (TS) will select "ghost" schedule and annual leave slots for available schedules and leave. Any schedule or annual leave selected by EL, MS or TS will be available to another CPC for selection.
- d. Lines marked as "Mid B/U" are mid back-ups for when the mid is vacant for any reason. With the exception of the Mon/Tues mid back-up, if the mid back-up is assigned to the mid, their shifts will be changed as follows: 5th Shift 2300. Mon/Tues mid back-up will be changed as follows: 5th shift 0000 No Flex.
- e. The Parties agree that CPC-ITs Brian Mahilo (XI) and Ryan Kolling (RX) and Trainee Seth Mathies (ST) will select CPC schedules and annual leave with CPCs for the entire 2026 BWS.
