To encourage you to relearn/review what you have not yet mastered or misunderstood, you may submit a quiz reflection and correction. You will have an opportunity to reflect on and correct Quiz 1 to receive up to 50% of the points that you lose on Quiz 1.

If you missed the quiz, we must assign a zero grade to your quiz 1. You can obtain a copy of a blank quiz from Brightspace > Quizzes. You can submit quiz 1 reflection & correction to receive up to 5 points (i.e., 50% of the points that you lose).

### What to submit:

#### 1. A .pdf copy of your \*graded\* quiz

- Since there are multiple versions of the quiz,
  - If you took the quiz, you **MUST submit your graded quiz copy and do a reflection & correction based on YOUR graded quiz.**
    - Note: the version of the blank copy from Brightspace may or may not be the version that you took. Be sure to use your version of the quiz.
  - If you did not take the quiz, you will use a blank copy of the quiz (available on Brightspace) to do a reflection & correction. Please note in your write-up that you did not take the quiz.
- Log in to Gradescope
- Access your graded quiz page
- Download your **graded quiz** – the button to download is at the bottom of the page



#### 2. A brief write-up discussing the following:

- What mistake did you make?
- Why did you make it?
- How will you make sure to not make this mistake again? What could you do better next time? What did you learn from taking this quiz and doing this reflection?
- What is the correct solution? Correct it.

Save your write-up as a .pdf (only typed PDF is accepted) or .txt file. — **No handwriting. No Word document.**

Remember to submit your **graded quiz** along with your write-up. No need to zip the files.

Submit your quiz reflection and correction to **Gradescope > quiz1-reflection & correction**

Making your submission available to course staff (instructor and TA) is **your** responsibility; if we cannot access or open your file then you will not get credit. Be sure to verify that you submit the correct files and all files can be opened before the deadline.

Please note: the quiz reflection and correction is optional. You are encouraged to do this activity. The purpose of this activity is to help you review, reflect, and possibly refactor your learning strategies.
