###Getting to Olympia Stadion

By S-Bahn:

- Take the S5 line directly to the Olympia-Stadion station. This line serves various parts of the city, making it a convenient option for attendees coming from different areas. Once you arrive, there are two main exits from the station. For those heading to the Main Stage, use the south exit; it's closer and offers a direct route. If you're starting your day at Stage Two or the Acoustic Lounge, opt for the north exit. Signs will guide you to the respective entrances of the Olympia Stadion.

###Getting to Olympia Stadion

By U-Bahn:

- The U2 line is your go-to option if you're traveling by U-Bahn. Alight at the Olympia-Stadion station. the U-Bahn station exit is more convenient for those looking to get directly to the Main Stage area. Attendees should follow the signs pointing towards the Olympia Stadion, ensuring an easy walk to the festival grounds.

###Getting to Olympia Stadion

By Bus:

- Bus lines M49 and 218 stop at the Flatowallee station, which is a short walk from the Olympia Stadion. After alighting from the bus, head towards the stadium; you'll find entrance gates for the Acoustic Lounge and Stage Two well-signposted along the route. This option might be preferable for those coming from areas not directly served by the S-Bahn or U-Bahn.

Additional Tips:

- Remember, Olympia Stadion is a large venue with several entrances. We highly recommend checking the festival map on our website or app to find the most convenient entrance for your first destination within the festival.
- For the most up-to-date information on public transport schedules, possible detours, or service interruptions during the festival weekend, please visit the official BVG (Berlin Verkehrsbetriebe) website or use their mobile app.
- Consider purchasing a day ticket if you plan to use public transport multiple times throughout the day. It offers unlimited rides and can be more economical.

Facilities and Amenities

Inside the Olympia Stadion (Main Stage)

- Restrooms: There are ample restroom facilities located around the perimeter of the stadium's interior. Accessible restrooms are also available.
- Food and Beverage: A variety of food stalls offering a range of culinary delights, from local Berliner specialties to international cuisine, are located throughout the concourse. Vegetarian and vegan options are available. Beverage stations serving soft drinks, water, beer, and other alcoholic beverages are conveniently situated near all seating areas.
- First Aid: First aid stations staffed by professional medical personnel can be found at key points around the stadium. If you or someone you're with needs medical attention, please don't hesitate to visit one of these stations.
- Merchandise: Official festival merchandise along with band merchandise will be available at several booths inside the stadium. This includes t-shirts, hats, posters, and exclusive festival memorabilia.
- Information Booths: Located near each major entrance, information booths can assist you with any questions, provide maps of the stadium and festival grounds, and offer lost and found services.

Facilities and Amenities

Outside the Olympia Stadion (Stage Two & Acoustic Lounge)

- Restrooms: Portable restroom units, including accessible options, are positioned in close proximity to both outdoor stages for your convenience.
- Food Trucks: To keep you fueled throughout the festival, a selection of food trucks featuring a variety of dishes, snacks, and desserts will be parked near each stage. Look out for some of Berlin's best street food offerings!

- Water Stations: Stay hydrated! Free water refill stations are available near both stages. Remember to bring your reusable water bottle.
- Chill Zones: We've set up several chill-out areas with seating and shade structures where you can relax, enjoy your food, or just take a break from the crowd and the excitement.
- Merchandise Tents: Don't miss out on picking up your festival and band merchandise from the tents located outside. These are in addition to the merchandise available inside the stadium.

Facilities and Amenities

General Facilities and Services

- Lost & Found: Lost something? Head to the nearest information booth or check our official festival website for the location of the central Lost & Found office.
- Wi-Fi: Free Wi-Fi access is available throughout the festival grounds. Connect to the festival network to stay in touch with friends and share your festival moments.

Entry Requirements

- Tickets: All attendees must present a valid ticket to enter the festival grounds. Tickets can be shown on a mobile device or as a printed copy. Ensure your ticket is easily accessible.
- ID Verification: Attendees may be required to show a valid photo ID to verify their age, especially for wristband access to alcohol. Acceptable forms of ID include a driver's license, passport, or other government-issued identification.
- Security Check: For the safety of all festival-goers, a security check will take place at all entrance points. Please be prepared to have your bags inspected.
- Age Restrictions: Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Some areas or performances may have additional age restrictions.

Prohibited Items

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone, the following items are not allowed within the festival grounds:

- Weapons of Any Kind: Including, but not limited to, firearms, knives, and explosives.
- Illegal Substances: Drugs and any illegal substances are strictly prohibited.
- Large Bags and Backpacks: Only small bags or backpacks (no larger than 12"x12") are allowed. All bags are subject to search.
- Alcohol: No outside alcohol is permitted on the festival grounds. A wide variety of beverages will be available for purchase.
- Glass Containers: For safety reasons, glass bottles and containers are not allowed.
- Professional Recording Equipment: Professional cameras, drones, and recording devices are prohibited unless previously accredited by the festival organizers.
- Pets: With the exception of service animals, pets are not allowed at the festival.

- Laser Pointers, Fireworks, and Flammable Liquids: These items pose a risk to safety and enjoyment and are strictly prohibited.
- Large Umbrellas and Chairs: To avoid obstructing views, large umbrellas and foldable chairs are not permitted. Small, personal umbrellas and blankets are acceptable.

Additional Information

- Re-entry Policy: Please be aware of the festival's re-entry policy. Depending on your ticket type, re-entry may not be permitted.
- Cashless Payments: Many vendors inside the festival will accept cashless payments only. Be prepared by bringing a debit card, credit card, or mobile payment method.

Festival Rules and Regulations

Respect and Responsibility:

- Respect each other, the artists, and all staff members. Aggressive behavior, harassment, and discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Look after your belongings. The festival is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Follow instructions from festival staff and security personnel at all times.

Alcohol Consumption:

- Alcohol Sales: At the festival, only beer and wine will be available for purchase.
- Under German law, individuals aged 16 and over are allowed to consume and possess fermented alcoholic beverages such as beer and wine. Valid photo ID is required for purchase.
- Drink responsibly. The festival reserves the right to refuse service to anyone visibly intoxicated or under the influence of drugs.
- No outside alcoholic beverages are allowed on festival grounds.

Smoking and Vaping:

- Smoking and vaping are only permitted in designated areas. Please respect non-smoking attendees and dispose of cigarette butts in provided containers.

Drug Policy:

- The possession, use, or distribution of illegal drugs or substances is strictly prohibited. Violators will be removed from the festival and may face legal consequences.

Photography and Recording:

- Personal cameras and mobile phones are welcome, but professional photography, video recording equipment, and drones are prohibited unless authorized by festival management.

- Respect the privacy of others. Always ask for consent before taking photos or videos of festival-goers.

Environmental Responsibility:

- Help us keep the festival grounds clean. Dispose of all waste in the appropriate recycling and trash bins located throughout the venue.
- Use water stations responsibly and consider bringing a reusable water bottle to minimize plastic waste.

Safety and Emergencies:

- In case of emergency, follow the instructions of security personnel and make your way to the nearest exit or emergency assembly point.
- First aid stations are located around the festival area. If you or someone else needs medical attention, please contact a staff member immediately.

Entry and Re-entry:

- Wristbands must be worn at all times for entry into the festival grounds. Damaged or tampered wristbands will not be accepted.
- Depending on the type of ticket purchased, re-entry may not be permitted. Please check the specific terms and conditions of your ticket.

Prohibited Items:

- As a reminder, items such as weapons, illegal substances, large bags, and glass containers are not allowed. For a full list of prohibited items, please refer to the "Entry Requirements and Prohibited Items" section.
