Dear Parents/Guardians of Springville Junior High Students:

For school attendance for the 2025/2026 school year, Utah State law requires the following immunizations for the protection of your child and others from communicable diseases:

5 DTaP	4 Polio	2 MMR	3 Hepatitis B	2 Hepatitis A	**2 Varicella (Chickenpox)
		1	l Meningococcal	1 Tdap	

The 5th DTP and 4th Polio immunizations need to be given after the child's 4th birthday, the first MMR and Chickenpox vaccines must be given after the first birthday.

To claim a personal, religious or medical exemption, the legal guardian must complete an online educational module (free of charge) and provide a copy of the completed form to the school official. The online course can be found at

https://immunize.utah.gov/immunization-education-module/. Remember to mark for all immunizations. Completion of the online educational module can be done at the Health Department if you do not have access to a computer. For a medical exemption, a written note from a licensed healthcare provider must be provided along with a copy of the completed online educational module. It should state the physical condition of the student, and why that vaccine would endanger the student's life or health.

Immunizations are available from your personal physician or from the Utah County Health Department (UCHD) at the following times and locations. If your child needs immunizations and you will be getting them at UCHD, please bring your records of previous immunizations when you come.

A physical examination, including vision screening, and a dental examination are strongly recommended for entering kindergarten students. UCHD Wellness Clinic performs physicals for \$45. Appointments can be made by calling 801-851-7031. Physical and dental exams and immunizations are advised in the spring or early summer to avoid crowds in the fall.
