Navigating the Course

Students often ask how they should go about completing the coursework. Below, I give my suggestions of how I would complete the module quizzes, video discussions, guided notes, and any additional assignments.

Step 1: Read the "Introduction & Overview" page for the module - as this will tell you what topics will be covered and any other relevant course information for that module

Step 2: Read the "Learning Materials" page for the module and review what assignments are due in that module.

Step 3: Begin watching the lecture and take notes as you watch.

Panopto Quizzes (worth 10% of your overall grade): At 3-4 different points in the lecture there will be interactive quiz questions that pop up. The questions will test you on the content covered right before. When the questions appear, you will choose the correct answer. You are welcome to use your notes to answer these questions. You must answer ALL of the quiz questions to get a grade for the quiz. If you do not answer all of the questions, you will have an incomplete grade when you check your score in the Canvas Gradebook. Here is some further information about taking quizzes in Panopto. You can submit corrections for your Panopto quizzes! If you get questions wrong, you can send me a Canvas message telling me on what slide/video you found the correct answer - and I will award you up to half credit back.

Flipgrid Video Discussions (worth 5% of your overall grade): At one point in the lecture, I will provide a discussion question. After the lecture, you will leave a video response to this question using Flipgrid. If you feel uncomfortable being on camera, you are welcome to cover it and record an audio response instead. This response should be at least 30 seconds long and no longer than 3 minutes. In addition, you should watch one of your classmates' video responses and leave a comment. You will receive 3 points for your response, and 2 points for responding to one of your classmates' video responses. Here is some further information about leaving a video response in Flipgrid, but generally the Flipgrid activity will load right in the assignment on Canvas.

Step 4: Complete the Module Journal, drawing on the course content covered in the lecture and textbook! Make sure that you ALWAYS do your module journals as they are worth 20% of your overall grade

Step 5: Complete any other assignments in the module (i.e. Self-Care Plan, Qualities of a Human Service Professional Mini-Essay)
