Every year we need to find about 800.000 cubic meters of empty land just to bury the garbage. This is the same as filling one football stadium with garbage up to 20 meters high!

This garbage damages the environment. Although a lot of garbage is buried in the ground, some of it gets blown about in the wind. Also, when garbage is burnt, **poisonous** gases are given off into the air. The garbage thrown into the sea will pollute the water.

What can we do about these problems? One very easy answer is to produce less garbage. We can recycle things made from glass and paper as well as tin cans. Jeju Island is the largest island of South Korea, with an area of 1846 square kilometers. It is also one of the nine provinces of the country, and the smallest of all of them. It was formed as a result of a volcanic eruption.

Jeju City is the capital of Jeju Island, and Halla Mountain is the key landmark of this island. It is also the tallest mountain in South Korea, with a height of 6,400 feet. This island has a temperate climate and it rarely falls below freezing, not even in winter. It is home to almost 950 different insect species, 198 bird species, 17 mammal species, and 8 reptile species.

Jeju Island is one of the new seven natural wonders of the world, and it has the finest lava tube system of caves in the world. The peak of the Halla Mountain looks like a giant crater, and is actually a **dormant** volcano, which means it has been inactive for years. There is a lake inside the crater, which is called Baengnokdam.
