Chick-fil-A Community Scholars- DEADLINE: November, 3, 2026

- **21st Century Scholarship**
Students must complete the activities in their [scholartrack](#) account and file the FAFSA their senior year to receive the scholarship funds for college. [IUB](#) and [Purdue University](#) also offer matching scholarships to cover the cost of room and board for 21st Century Scholars (the scholarship is for tuition). To learn more and to complete the activities:
Students must be automatically enrolled in or apply to the 21st Century Scholars program by June 30 of the end of their 8th-grade year. The only exception is that

students in foster care may enroll in high school. Indiana offers many other [financial aid programs](#) if students miss the enrollment deadline.

- **Workforce Ready Grant**

The Workforce Ready Grant covers the **full tuition and required fees** for eligible high-value certificate programs at Ivy Tech Community College, Vincennes University, Indiana Tech or other authorized providers. The Baccalaureate/Doctor of Medicine Degree Scholarship is a program seeking to enhance the state's efforts in medical education, research, and services, creating a focus on medical issues in Indiana.
