**Do**: Use "do" for first and second singular and plural subjects like "I," "you," "we," and third person plural subjects like "they and "Ski and Sam"."

## **Examples:**

- I do my homework
- Do you like pizza?
- Do Mia and June work in health care?

**Does**: Use "does" for third person singular subjects like "he," "she," or "it."

# Examples:

Remember

- She does her homework
- does walk
- Does he like ice cream?"
- does walks

**Negative Statements:** Add "not" (contracted to "don't" for "do" and "doesn't" for "does") to make negative sentences.

# Examples:

- I don't like spinach
- He doesn't play basketball.

"Do (하다)": "I," "you," "we"와 같은 1인칭 및 2인칭 단수 및 복수 주어, 그리고 "they"와 "Ski 그리고 Sam"과 같은 3인칭 복수 주어에 "do"를 사용합니다.

"Does (하다)": "he," "she," 또는 "it"와 같은 3인칭 단수 주어에 "does"를 사용합니다.

- 그는 아이스크림을 좋아하나요?

부정문: 부정 문장을 만들려면 "do"에 "not"를 추가하고 (축약 형태로 "don't" 사용) "does"에 "not"를 추가하고 (축약 형태로 "doesn't" 사용) 사용합니다.
