GUIDE TO SETTING UP RYUJINX NINTENDO SWITCH EMULATOR TO PLAY TSUKIHIME

Before we start, you should make sure that your computer hardware meets the minimum requirements for Yuzu.

- At least 8GB RAM
- A video card/GPU that supports OpenGL 4.5 or higher
- OS-specific dependencies installed

1. What you need to download first:


- Ryujinx emulator: Go to the official website and download it: https://ryujinx.org/download
- Keys file (for new firmware), please make sure you have the keys file for the newest Switch firmware: https://prodkeys.net/prod-keys/
- Switch firmware (newest version): https://darthsternie.net/switch-firmwares/
- Tsukihime NSP file: https://nyaa.si/view/1425243
- Tsukihime update 1.0.1: <u>Download Link</u> <u>Alternative Link</u>

2. Set up Ryujinx Emulator and playing Tsukihime with it

1. Extract Ryujinx and then open Ryujinx. You will meet this message, but don't worry. Its normal




2. Click file at the top left -> Open Ryujinx folder




3. Go to the System sub-folder. Extract prod.keys into here


Roaming > Ryujinx > system



- 4. Close Ryujinx and reopen it. You shouldn't see the error message again
- 5. Click on Tools -> Install firmware -> Install firmware from XCI or ZIP




- 6. Click on the firmware you have downloaded. A box will appear and ask you to install the fimrware -> Click Yes
- 7. Wait a minute for it to finish
- 8. With Ryujinx open, click Options -> Settings



9. Click the button Add.



10. Nagative to the folder that contains Tsukihime nsp file -> Click Add




- 11. Click Save the setting, your games will now show up on Ryujinx
- 12. Double click at Tsukihime to play the game
- 13. If you want to stop the game, click Action on the top bar -> Stop emulation


Warning: If you experience low fps, lagging in the opening of the game, don't give up. The opening of the game is very laggy, but after you go through it, it will be more stable. You should wait for the opening to finish


3. How to install update for Tsukihime

1. Right click on the game -> Manage Titles Update




2. Click on add -> nagative to the directory of your tsukihime update 1.0.1 file





3. Click on version 1.0.1 -> Save




4. Tsukihime will list as 1.0.1 in Ryujinx




4. How to map your controls in Ryujinx

Since Tsukihime is a visual novel, you can play it on your keyboard with no downside. But you need to config controls first


1. Click on Option -> Setting -> Input -> Make sure Docked mode, Keyboard access and direct mouse access is enabled



2. Click Configure on Player 1
